



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TO DEVELOP A COST SHARING POLICY

Introduction

Youth Initiative for Community Development (YICOD) is local organization established in response to the growing need for community-driven solutions to challenges facing children, young people and women in Dedza district. It was founded by a group of young professionals with a shared passion for promoting good governance, community development and began its initiatives with promoting child rights in the district. Over the years, the organisation has expanded its thematic areas and currently includes: economic empowerment, governance, gender equality and social inclusion, child protection, education, food systems, health, Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH), and climate change adaptation and mitigation. YICOD is registered with Malawi Government under the Trustees Incorporation Act (CAP.5:03), National Youth Council of Malawi, Council for Non-Governmental Organization in Malawi, NGO Regulatory Authority and Malawi Revenue Authority.

YICOD received **Core Support Funding** from IM Swedish Development Partner to support its strategic objectives. The support is instrumental in strengthening YICOD's capacity, and ensuring the effective implementation of its long-term vision. Other than enhancing organizational development, the core support is also used in addressing the gaps of the previous Food and Nutrition Security project that YICOD implemented as well as scaling up the interventions' (best practices) that were there.

Therefore, it is against this background that YICOD is seeking the services of a competent and experienced consultant (Individual/Firm) to support in the development of the **Cost Sharing Policy**.

Minimum Requirements and Competencies

- Minimum of a Master of Science Degree in Accounting, Finance, Auditing or a Business-related field and registered with either ICAM, ACCA, CFA, and in good standing.
- A minimum of 5 years' progressive experience in financial management or institutional strengthening for the NGO sector with a sound background in Finance, Accounting, Auditing and Procurement.
- Experience in working with Local and International NGOs, knowledge of donor expectations, audit and grant compliance, and firsthand experience in facilitating the development of cost-sharing mechanisms.
